- **Who May Apply:** Local floodplain professionals, local government, or community officials
- **Application Deadline:** Thursday, February 20
- **How to Apply:** send an email message to Laura Hendrix at lhendrix@ravallicounty.mt.gov confirming your attendance at the required session and field visit (below) and note your position in local government. Scholarships awarded on a first come/first served basis.

- **Scholarship Includes:** Conference Registration Fee Only (\$120 for AMFM members, \$160 for non-members)
- **Scholarship Requirements:** Must participate in “Floodplain Wetland Session” from 1:30-4:45 pm Wednesday, March 4th AND participation in “Floodplain Wetland Field Tour” on Thursday, March 5th from 9:15 am-1:00 pm (lunch provided)

Strategic Floodplain Mapping Scholarship

- **Who May Apply:** Local floodplain professionals, local government, community officials, or interested citizens.
- **Application Deadline:** Thursday, February 20th. Also submit AMFM Conference registration including registration fee by Sunday, February 15th to AMFM.
- **How to Apply:** Send an email message to Bri Shipman at bshipman@mt.gov expressing your interest in floodplains and floodplain mapping for the state. Registration fee will be reimbursed at conference. Other expenses will be reimbursed at a later date.
- **# Scholarships:** up to 10
- **Scholarship Includes:** Conference Registration Fee (\$120 for AMFM members, \$160 for non-members), lodging for 2 nights (about \$150), and mileage reimbursement.
- **Scholarship Requirements:** Must participate in “Strategic Floodplain Mapping Planning” session on Thursday, March 5th from 1:30-5:30 pm and have an interest in serving on the newly forming Floodplain Mapping Task Force.
